<b>Purpose</b>	To regulate student access to and usage of harmful substances such as alcohol, tobacco products and illegal drugs.

## Harmful Substances Procedure

1. The Principal will personally and via teachers make known to all students, staff, parents and volunteers that smoking at or near school or during any school outing is forbidden. Smoking is forbidden in all vehicles used for student transport.
2. Students are not permitted to consume, possess, or be under the influence of alcohol, tobacco and tobacco products, over-the-counter drugs capable of impairing judgement unless prescribed for medical reasons, illegal drugs and all implements associated with drug use at school and during any school related activity including excursions and camps.
3. Students who are in offence of the above clause will be dealt with in accordance of the FRSA R004 Student Discipline Policy. The parents will be informed.
4. All staff members are to serve as a positive role model by their wholesome examples, positive dialogue, and restrained use of alcohol and tobacco products. The use of over-the-counter drugs capable of impairing the vigilance or judgement of supervisors is prohibited, unless prescribed for medical reasons.
